Preferences and Refining Search

1. Once you have searched for a book, you have the option to refine the current search or apply preferences (these will save across the Libby Library). “Refine” will appear on the right side of the screen and “Preferences” will appear on the left side.

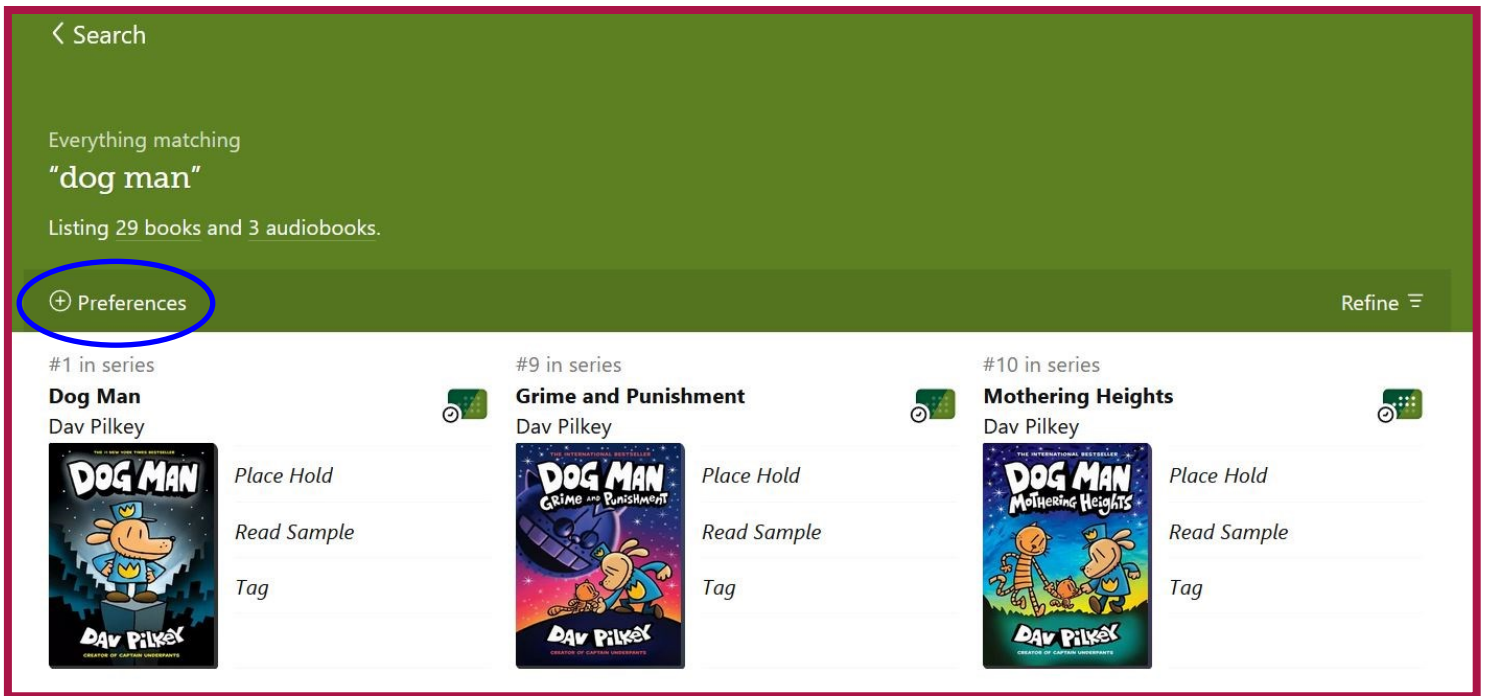


2. To refine the search, click on **“Refine”** on the right side of the screen. A new window will pop up to choose from several options. “Format” (Books and Audiobooks), “Subject,” “Language,” “Audience,” (age group), “Supports,” (Libby Book, Kindle, etc.), “Availability,” and “Sort by” (popularity, relevance, release date, etc.).



3. You can also search within your initial results (this option will be listed after "Sort By"). This helps when you cannot find the title you are looking for right away. A new window will pop up, to type in the new search term (picture example: Lord of the Fleas). After clicking "Search", new results will appear with the title you are looking for.





4. To add preferences, click on **“Preferences”** on the left side of the screen. A new window will pop up with options to choose from. Format” (Books and Audiobooks), “Language,” “Audience,” (age group), “Supports,” (Libby Book, Kindle, etc.), “Availability,” and “Sort by” (popularity, relevance, release date, etc.). Then click **“Apply Preferences”** and your choices will be applied to all lists in the Libby Library.
