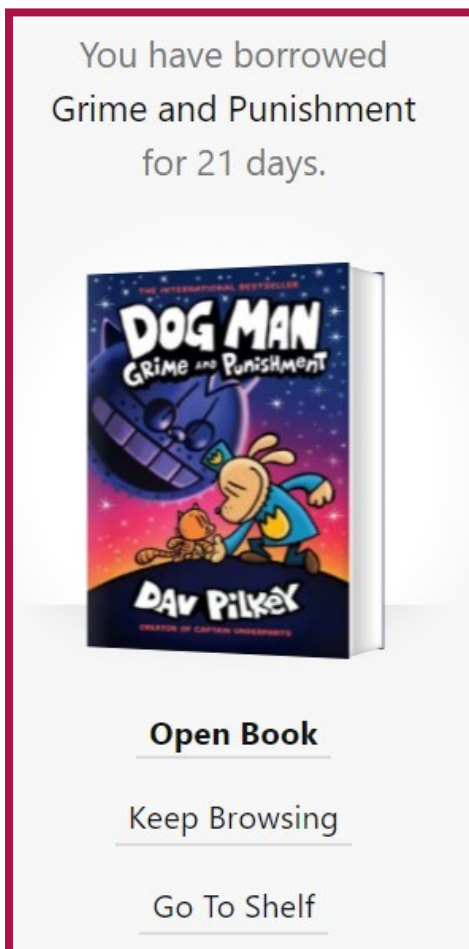
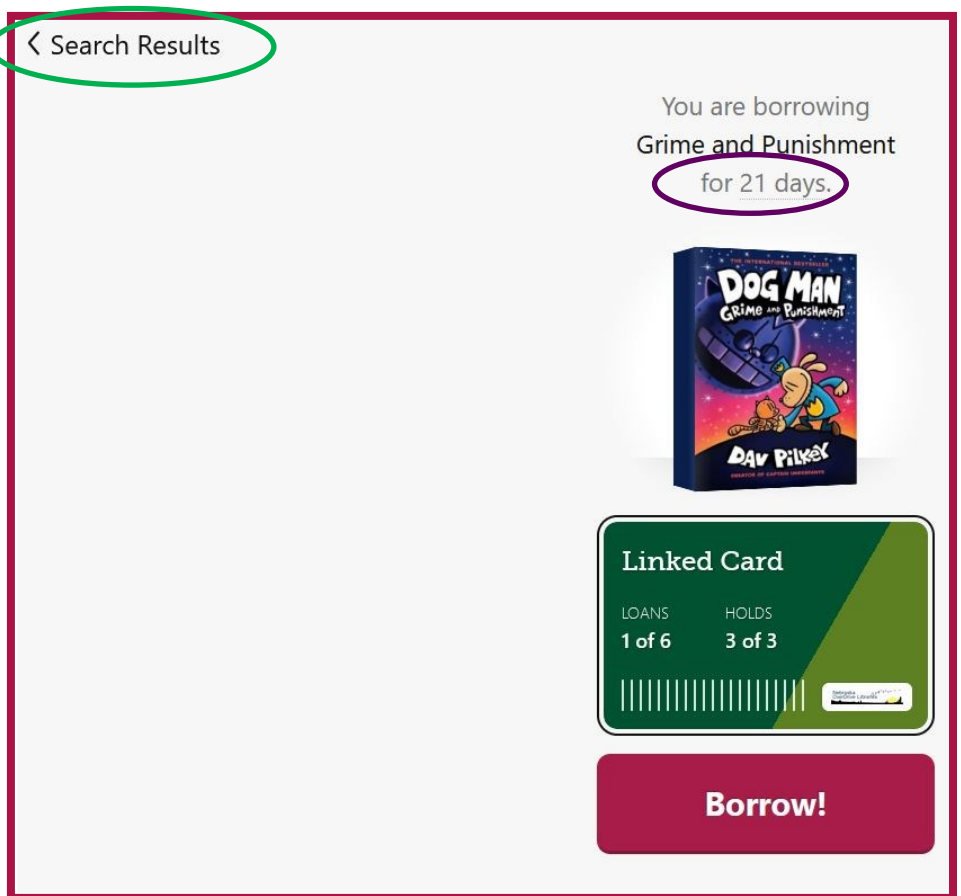
Borrowing an Item

1. Once you have found a book to check out, you should see a “Borrow” to the right of the cover [where “Place Hold” would be if the item is unavailable].
2. Select the “Borrow” button.

4. Once you select “Borrow”, you will get a confirmation page that will give you options on what to do next: “Open Book”, “Keep Browsing”, or “Go To Shelf”.

There will also be a circle to the left of the book cover that will show the book’s download progress. It will have a check mark in the middle once it is fully downloaded.
