We are entering summer with cautious optimism that many of the events and activities that make Papillion a vibrant community can safely resume in some capacity.

First and foremost, the Papillion Community Foundation is currently planning to host Papillion Days from June 17 through June 20. We will have more information in next month's letter, but current plans do include the parade, carnival, fireworks show and vendors in the park. Follow the Papillion Community Foundation on social media and stay tuned for more details.

The Papillion Recreation Department also has a number of facilities, programs and events that will resume this summer, of course with COVID-19 precautions in place as necessary:

- Papio Bay Aquatic Center will open Saturday, May 29 with capacity restrictions.
- SumTur Amphitheater will resume free community movie nights and concerts with capacity restrictions in place as well. (Also, Papillion La Vista Community Theatre recently announced they would be returning to the SumTur stage this summer as well.)
- The Papillion Farmers Market begins June 2 and continues every Wednesday evening through September 29.
- The Papillion Race Series has a full slate of events beginning with the Papillion Half Marathon, 10K & 5K Fun Run on May 16.
