SYNOPSIS

The State of Nebraska Statutes, sections 39-2115, 39-2119, 39-2120, 39-2121, and 39-2520(2), require an annual certification of program compliance to the Nebraska Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards (NBCS).

State of Nebraska Statute, section 39-2120 also requires the Mayor of each municipality to sign the annual certification of program compliance to include the City Council resolution authorizing the signing of the certification

Municipalities are still required to adopt a One-and-Six-Year Road Plan, even though it is not required to be filed with the NBCS. Likewise, municipalities must continue to maintain accounting systems and public records as specified in Neb. Rev. Stat. §39-2120 and §39-2510(2) or §39-2520(2) even though the SSAR report is not required to be filed with the NBCS.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City is required to send an adopted and signed Municipal Annual Certification of Program Compliance to the NDOT following approval of the One-and-Six-Year Road Plan and the Annual Budget to avoid suspension of highway allocation distributions.

BACKGROUND

LB82 became law on March 7, 2019, changing the NBCS's municipal highway, road, and street public record keeping and reporting requirements. The 2021 One-and-Six-Year Road Plan was approved by Council on August 17, 2021, through Resolution R21-0149. Council approved the FY 21/22 Budget on September 7, 2021 through Ordinance No. 1937.
